ASSOCIATION ACTIVITIES DURING 2023 AND TO DATE

In 2023, UCA membership grew 14%. The year was full of conferences and programs that produced valued content and record participation.

Conferences

- The George A. Fox Conference, held on January 31st, 2023, in New York, NY, was attended by 481 participants.
- The Rapid Excavation and Tunneling Conference (RETC), held June 11th – 14th, 2023, in Boston, Massachusetts, drew 1,400 attendees and featured a record number of exhibit booths.
- The Cutting Edge Conference, held November 13th – 15th, 2023, in Austin, TX, had a record attendance of 327 and featured a field trip to the Brushy Creek

Regional Utility Authority.

The George A. Fox Conference, held on February 8th, 2024 in New York, NY, had a record attendance of 515 participants.

Programs

- The Student Outreach Committee or "Down for That" hosted eight tunnel tours and a full-day field course for students.
- Three academic and 30 conference participation scholarships were provided to students.
- The Teach the Professors program helped ten professors develop a tunneling and underground construction curriculum for implementation in 2024.
- The Owners Form hosted a panel session

at RETC and two virtual networking opportunities for project owners.

- Women in Tunneling hosted a breakfast at RETC attended by 300+ participants. The group held a tunnel tour in October for approximately 20 participants.
- The Government & Public Affairs Committee (GPAC) hosted a federal fly-in in conjunction with the American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE). The Tunnel Watch List Committee outlined projects that, if funded, would provide great value to the US.
