The two biggest underground works are:

Metro4 Budapest construction and Bátaapti radioactive waste repository.

Metro4: The progress of the whole project reached the 98% by the end of 2013. The remaining works as follows (the more important ones, only):

- Structural facility works as exit-structures at Kelenföld with parking and at Keleti RailSt
- Metro-trains already having the authorised permitions (stations and tunnels as well), so the test-running will start on the $1^{\rm st}$ January 2014 and expectedly the official opening ceremony of the Line 4 will be on 30st March 2014.
