Various online Steering Board Meetings were held in the first half of this year during which the prospect of a joint conference between PIARC and ITA COSUF on New Energy Carriers in Road Tunnels has been discussed. This joint event of PIARC and ITA COSUF will be a next step to strengthen the partnerships. Now, hopefully the time is ready to reach out for physical meetings, although the risk of a new Covid 19 peak in November or December 2021 is not negligible. Therefore, PIARC, ITA COSUF and KPT have decided to organize a physical Workshop on New Energy Carriers in Road Tunnels on 20-21 October 2021 in Utrecht, the Netherlands. The General Assembly 2021 and Activity Group Meetings will be part of this event.

document will probably be launched during a future ITA COSUF webinar.
