2. Report of the 3rd European Forum of Road Tunnel Safety Officers in Luxembourg (26-28 March 2014)

Tunnel safety experts from 16 European countries met in Luxembourg on 27 and 28 March, seeking to make road tunnels safer in Europe. Under EU legislation Member States are required to appoint a tunnel safety officer for tunnels covered by the Directive. These officers are in charge of coordinating preventive and safeguarding measures to ensure the safety of tunnel users and the personnel operating and maintaining them. More than forty safety officers took part in the third European Forum of Road Tunnel Safety Officers to address



key priorities, to learn from one another and to compare technical details on safety inspections. The officers also visited tunnels under construction in Luxembourg.

The forum was organised by the European Commission, ITA COSUF and the World Road Association (PIARC). The first forum was held in Lyon in 2009 and the second one in Brussels in 2014.

3. Next General Assembly and ITA COSUF, Workshop Berlin, 5 June 2014



This workshop will be hosted in Hotel Sylter Hof in Berlin and the theme is *Balancing Operational Needs and Safety Research Developments*. New road tunnel systems may have a large impact for tunnel operation. The workshop will highlight not only the benefit of new developments but also the downside for the tunnel safety management. However, the adaption of the tunnel operators may not be able to follow the speed of technological changes and a need for decision support systems is clear. The implementation of new safety research developments and interface challenges is a very interesting subject to ad-

dress. Please register as soon as possible!

4. Report of ISTSS 2014 endorsed by ITA COSUF



The 6th International Symposium on Tunnel Safety and Security (ISTSS) was held in Marseille, France, 12-14th in March 2014. The symposium provided an overview of emerging research and regulatory actions coupled to state-of-the-art knowledge in the field of safety and security in undergrounds structures. For this reason ITA COSUF decided to endorse this event and become an honorary sponsor. The symposium attracted over 225 delegates from all parts of the world. Almost 60 papers were presented and many contributions were dedicated to active fire protection, which has become a major field of interest. Other topics that attracted may papers were risk and engineering analysis. A

poster session was present with more papers to canvas other interesting emerging research as well as an exhibit to allow producers to present their particular solutions. Proceedings of the seminar are for sale via http://www.istss.se.
