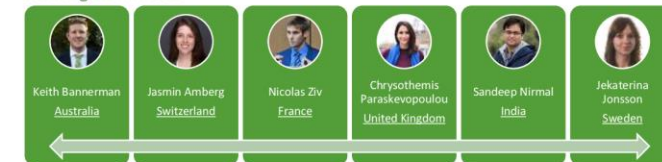
Main Activities

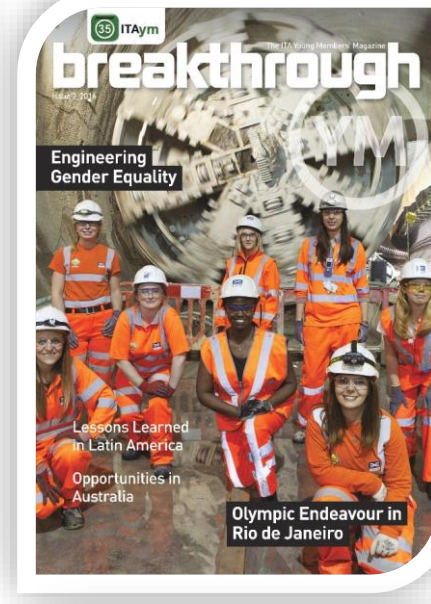
Activity Report

ITAYM have been involved in the following activities the last year:

- Successfully attended the WTC 2019 in Naples and elected a new steering committee member during the ITAYM general assembly;
- Held activities during the WTC 2019, including ITAYM social event with over 120 participants and a morning run;
- Worked towards ITA organisations to get young people involved and contribute actively in organization activities. This includes involvement in ITACUS and especially ITACET;
- Continued with the newsletter independent of Breakthrough including information from ym-groups all over the world. Have issued 8 newsletter the last 11 months (see appendices);
- Focused on being active on Social media, especially Facebook and LinkedIn;
- Celebrating Word Tunnel Day on 4th of December. Encouraging the national ym-groups to organize events and share their celebration on social media;

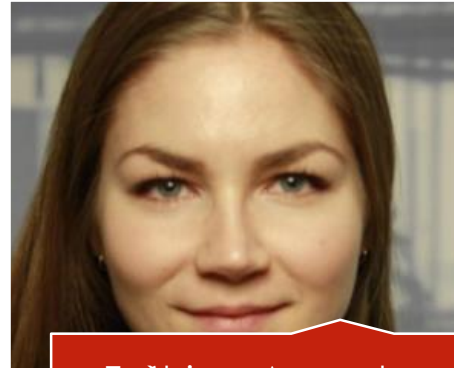
