VOTING PROCESS

- Open positions: 3 [Total members steering committee: 5]
- Number of Candidates: 6

Voting process:

- Every voting delegate has **as many votes as open positions** each round of ballot.
- For election **50% of votes** have to be reached.
There will be max. 4 rounds of ballot.
- In order to limit the number of rounds there is the candidate with the fewest number of votes will be excluded after each round.

After the last round of balloting, if any position remains open, the current ITAym steering committee can decide about the acceptance of the remaining candidates to the steering committee or leaving the position open.

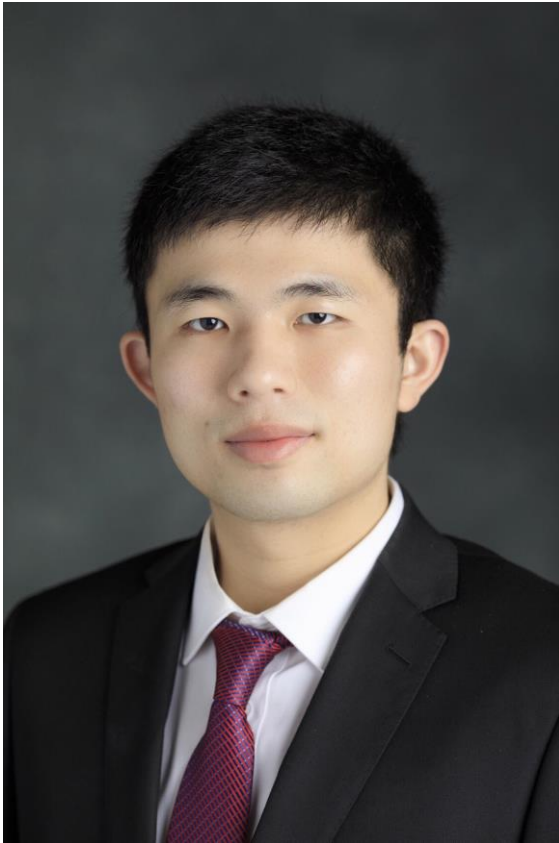

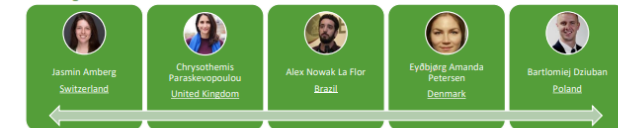

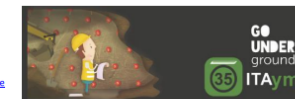
ITAym have been involved in the following activities the last year:
